

Assessor Valuation Guidelines

Assessors are bound by Minnesota State Statues and given direction by Minnesota Department of Revenue on how to establish estimated market values. Per <u>MN Statue</u> <u>273.11</u>, all property shall be valued at its market value. <u>https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/cite/273.11</u>
